1. Setting / Context / Transitions: Is the initial setting or context clearly evident? How is each setting or segment change represented auditorially, visually, spatially, or linguistically—via intertitles, transitions, or other means? What suggestions do you have for improvement?

2. Differentiation: Is each character/interview/subject matter differentiated in some way? What suggestions do you have for improvement?

3. Movement: Are important character or object movements indicated? 5. Sound effects / Soundtrack: Are sound effects or musical scores noted (usually under the dialogue or scene)? Do you indicate what these audio elements will be and how long or loud they will be? What suggestions do you have for improvement?
